★★★★★ I liked the part when the man went flying! - Jeremy age 7

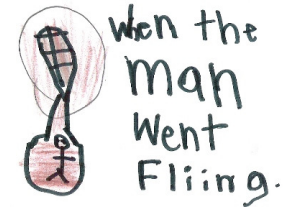
Private Eyes
